Our Story

EdgeMate began as an observation. Working at a waterpark (Wyandot Lake) just outside of Columbus, OH, I often saw guests with disabilities (typically children) having to switch out of their motorized wheelchairs into manual ones, just so they could experience the simple pleasure of being in the pool.

A few years later, the Americans with Disabilities Act expanded to include design standards (ex. poolside lifts, zero-depth entries, transfer walls, ramps) for swimming pools; legally mandated access for millions of people who previously had none.

All of this led to a simple question: Then what? A lift got somebody in the water, but there was nothing to keep them there. For the newfound access to have meaningful impact, there had to be something beyond holding onto a companion or the side of the pool.

Armed with PVC pipe and fittings, I spent countless hours in the garage intent on providing stable, comfortable, portable in-pool seating that served as the progression from access to enjoyment. Those efforts resulted in what would ultimately become the EdgeMate Pool Chair.

What began as an observation continues as an effort of inclusion. Inspired by individuals with disabilities, EdgeMate is intended for all. For the hotel/resort wanting to provide a new amenity for guests. For the accessible traveler seeking new adventures. And, most of all, for the people yearning to discover, or rediscover, the pure joy of being in the pool.

While opportunities for the accessible traveler continue to grow, there is still much to accomplish in terms of education and awareness. As our hotel/resort partners continue to offer designated access into the pool for their guests with disabilities, we at EdgeMate want to do our part and take care of the enjoyment.

As part of our Inclusion Initiative, we will supply, at each pool access point, an EdgeMate Pool Chair fitted with custom labeling that indicates exclusive use for accessible travelers.

Our Ultimate Goal: wherever there is access, there is EdgeMate.
